

**NOTICE OF RACE
CHAMPIONNAT DE FRANCE 5o5**

From 14 to 17 July 2016

Venue: Le Havre

Organising authority: Société des Régates du Havre

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*,
- 1.2 National prescriptions for foreign competitors are defined in joined appendix named "prescriptions"
- 1.3 FFvoile regulations
- 1.4 In case of translation of this notice of race, the French text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code) as modified by the Advertising regulation of the FFVoile, boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats in accordance with the 5o5 class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form attached and sending it, together with the required entry fee to Société des Régates du Havre – Quai Eric Tabarly – 76600 Le Havre, no later than 1 July 2016. **After July 1, it is still possible to register but the costs will be increased by 20 €.**
- 3.3 Competitors (each crew member) having a FFVoile licence shall present during registration:
 - their valid FFVoile licence with medical stamp, or accompanied with a medical certificate (dated less than one year) certifying the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition and a parental authorization for the minors,
 - if necessary a valid authorization to display advertising on boat
 - the measurement form or certificate of the boat
- 3.4 Foreign competitors (each crew member) without a FFVoile licence shall present during registration
 - a supporting document to justify their membership to an ISAF Member national authority.
 - the measurement form or certificate of the boat,
 - a proof to be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1 500 000 Euros.
 - a medical certificate (in French or in English) dated less than one year, certifying the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition and a parental authorization for the minors

4. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee will be as follows:

5. SCHEDULE

- Thursday, July 14 from 8:00 to 12:00

5.2 Measurement and stamping:

- Wednesday, July 13, from 14:00 to 18:00
- Thursday, July 14 from 9:00 to 12:00

5.3 Dates of racing

- Thursday, July 14: first warning signal at 2:00 p.m.
- Friday, July 15: first warning signal at 1:00 p.m.
- Saturday, July 16: first warning signal at 1:00 p.m.
- Sunday, July 17: first warning signal at 10:00

5.4 The last day of the regatta, no warning signal will be done after 1:00 p.m.

5.5 Festivities

- Thursday, July 14: welcome cocktail on the terrace of SRH at 8:00 p.m.
- Friday, July 15: raid back after the races - specific ranking.
BBQ on the terrace of SRH at 8:00 p.m. **(20€ per person)**
- Saturday, July 16: general meeting of the class at the SRH restaurant at 10am
- Sunday, July 17: prizes ceremony on the terrace of SRH at 4:00 p.m.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The sailing instructions and their appendices will be
- available during confirmation of registration
 - posted on the official notice board (SRH's restaurant windows)

7. THE COURSES

7.1. There will be windward/leeward courses.

7.2. The location of the racing areas will be described in the appendix RACING AREA.

8. SCORING

3 races are required to be completed to complete the event.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10. PRIZES

Gifts can be distributed at the prizes ceremony. The title of champion of France of 505 will be awarded to the winning crew of the championship.

11. DECISION TO RACE

The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. Consequently, accepting to participate in a race or to continue racing, the competitor disclaims the organizing authority of any liability for damage (material and/or personal injury).

APPENDIX "PRESCRIPTIONS"

FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2013-2016
Applying to foreign competitors

RRS 64.3 (*):

The jury may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

RRS 67 (*):

Any question about or request of damages arising from an incident involving a boat bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing or International Regulation to Prevent Collision at Sea depends on the appropriate courts and will not be dealt by the jury.

RRS 70.5 (*):

In such circumstances, the written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile shall be received before publishing the notice of race and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

RRS 78 (*):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat comply with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

RRS 86.3 (*):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1 in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such authorization shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

RRS 88 (*):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall be neither changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall be neither changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website www.ffvoile.fr, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

RRS 91 (*):

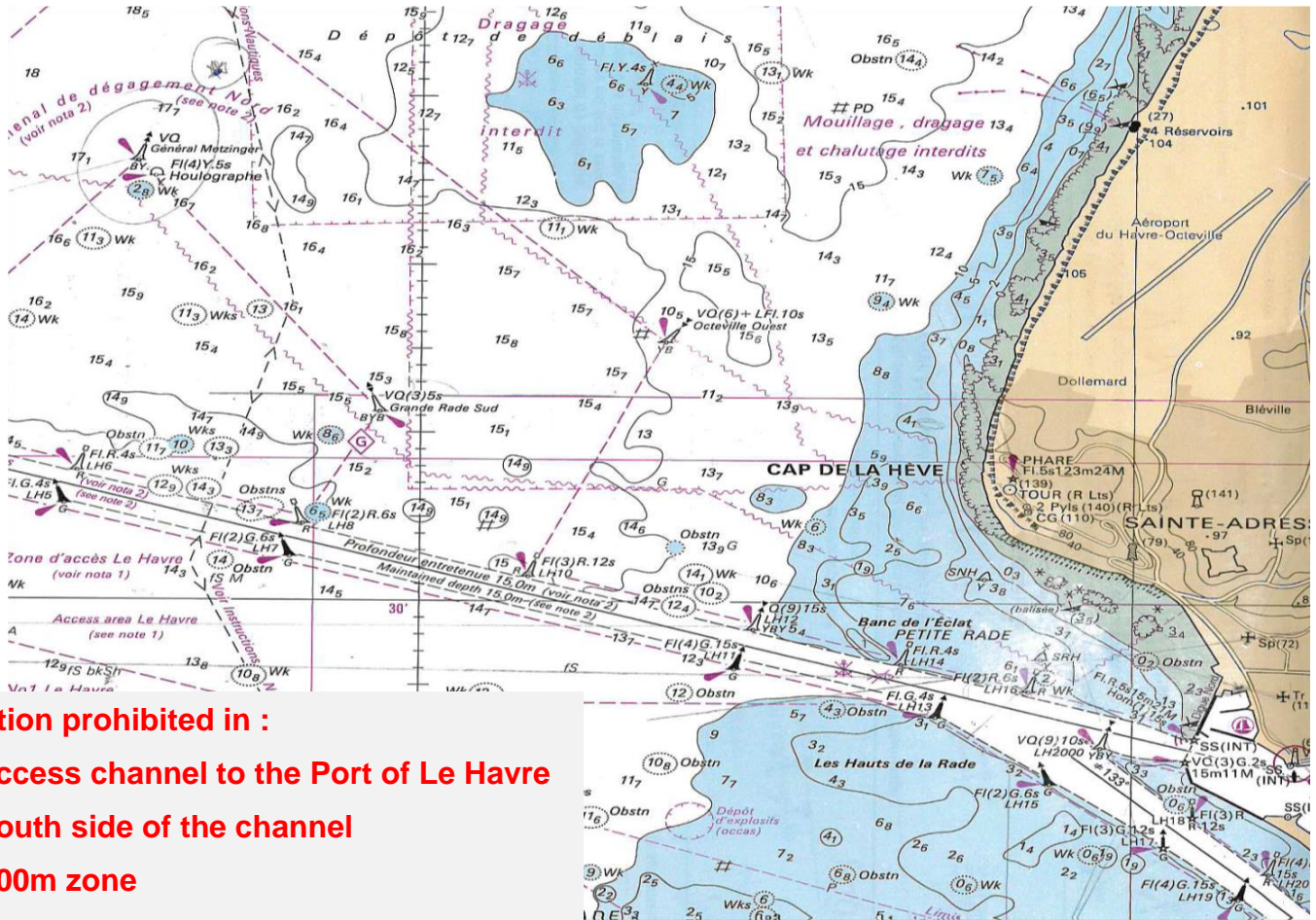
The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile. Such notice of approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
